The information describes First Nations vaccines that have been recorded in PHIMS as of October 19, 2023. Since many communities do not have access to PHIMS directly we know many more doses have been administered in the communities but have not yet been recorded in PHIMS. We continue to work to address the delay so that the numbers we report more accurately reflect the excellent work going on in communities.

Total Doses Administered

Total number of vaccinations: **333,742**

- 3703 First Nations received 5 doses
- 13,140 First Nations received 4 doses
- 45,682 First Nations received 3 doses
- 129,231 First Nations people received 2 doses
- 141,969 First Nations people received 1 dose








Distribution-sex
