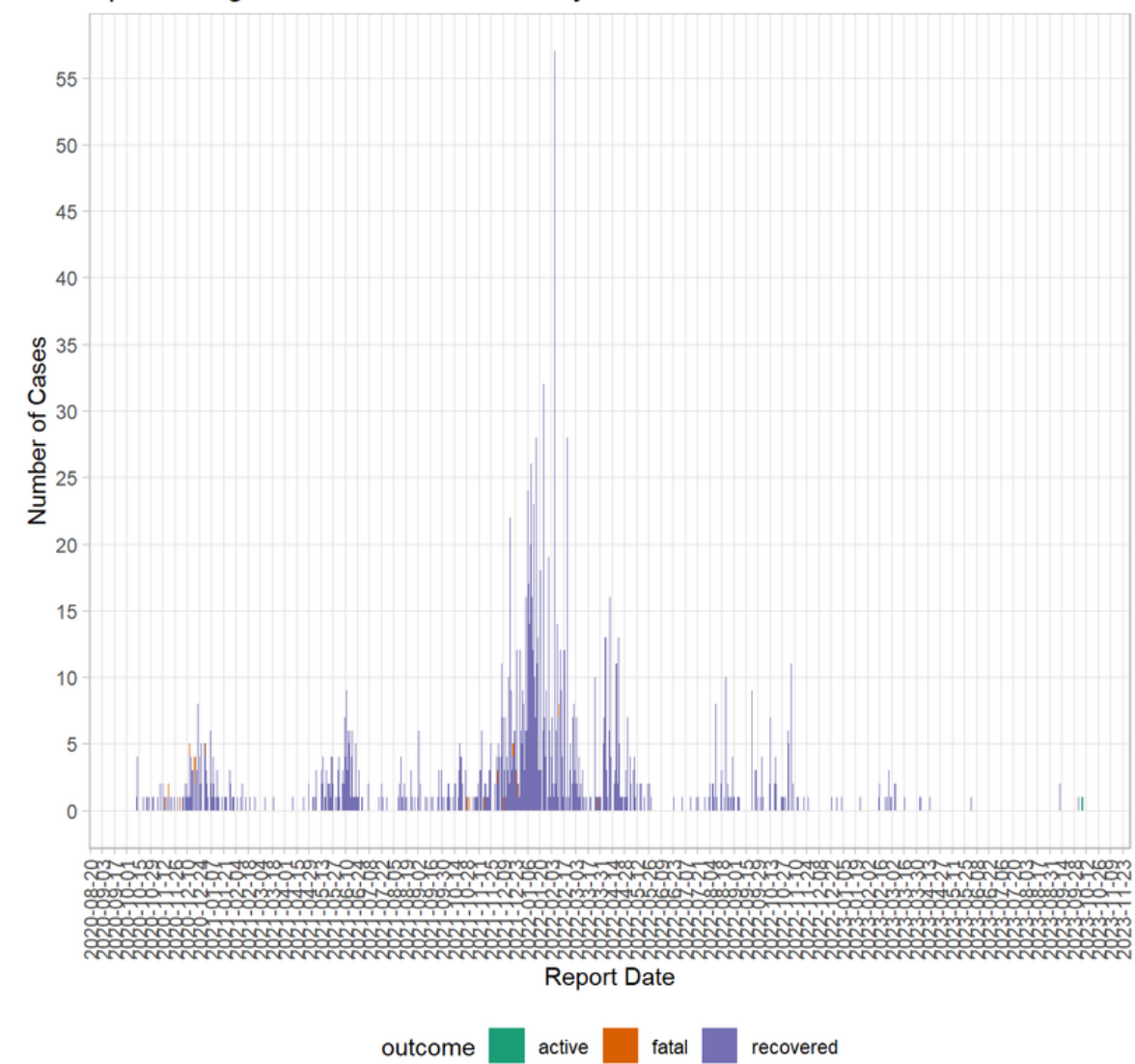

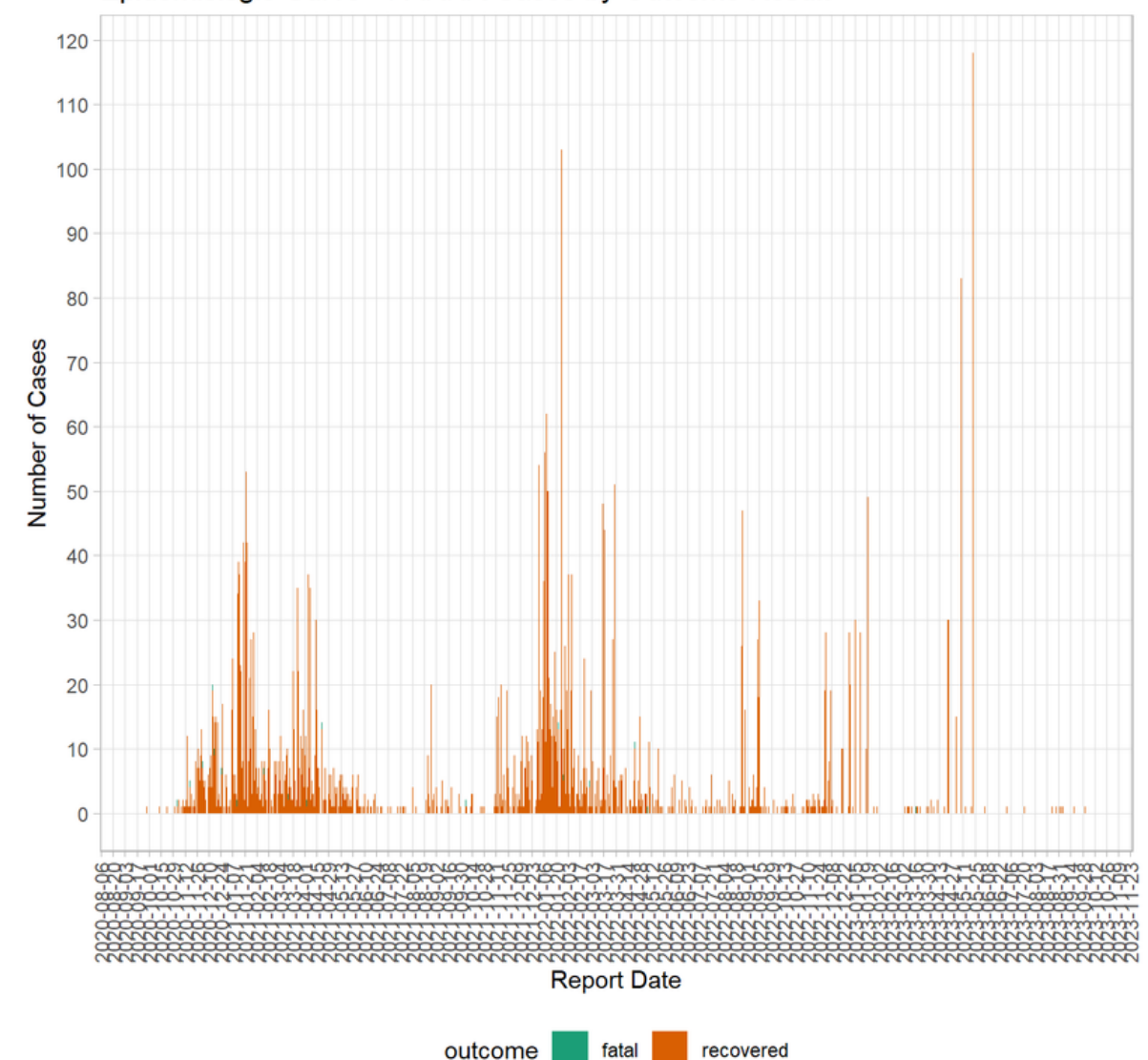
Epidemiologic Curve - DOTC Cases by Outcome Result

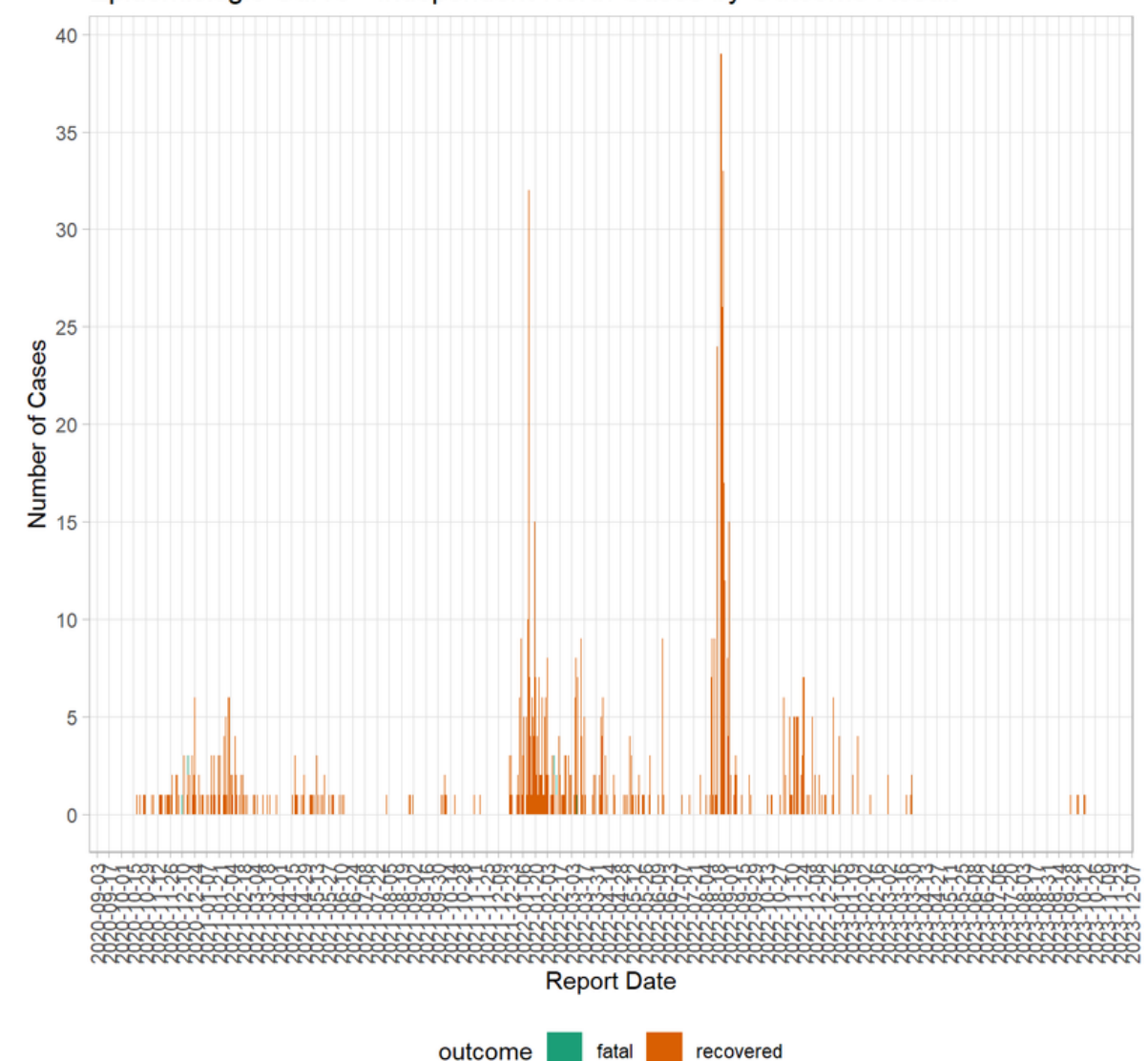
Epidemiologic Curve - FARHA Cases by Outcome Result

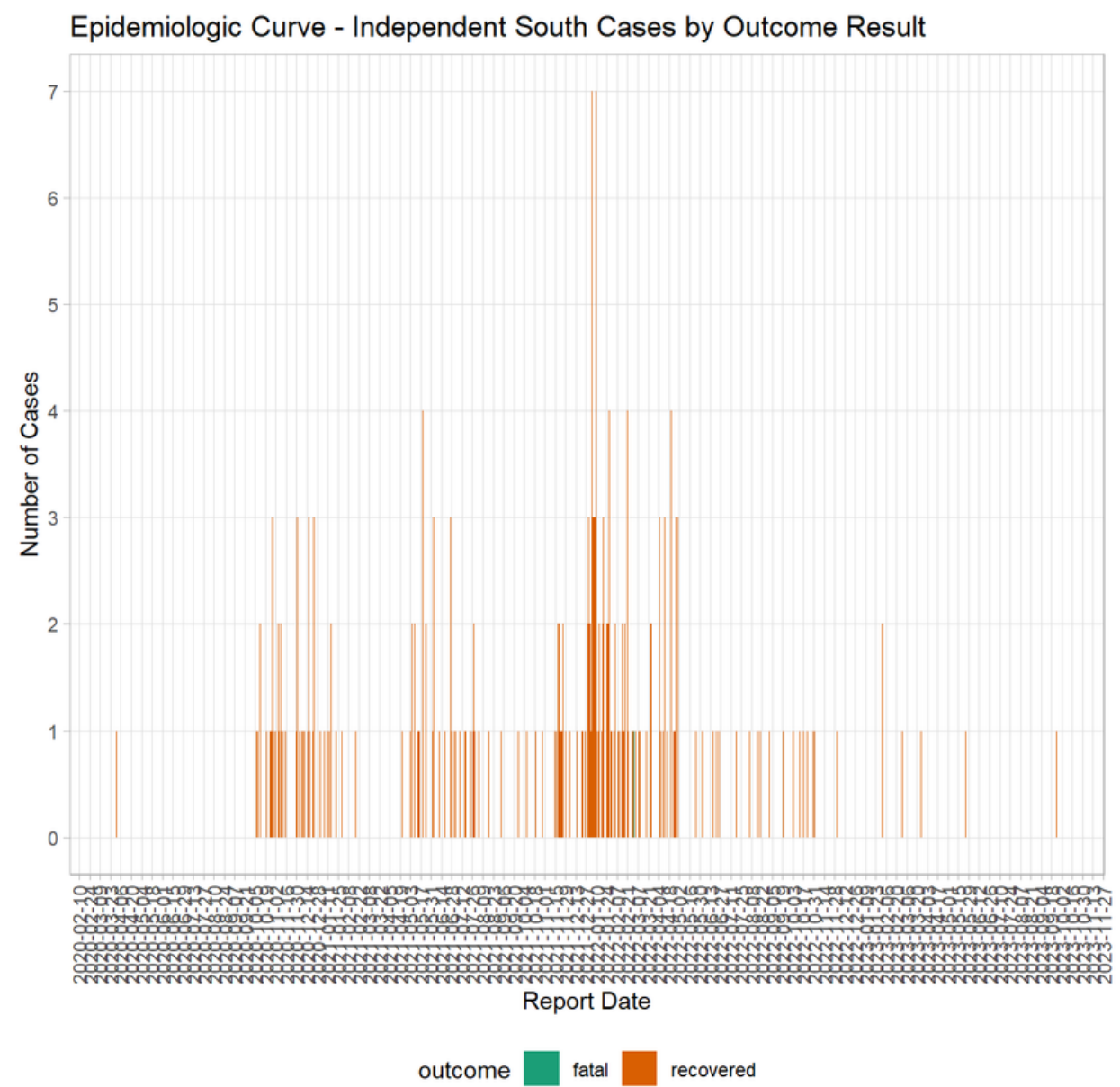

Epidemiologic Curve - Independent North Cases by Outcome Result



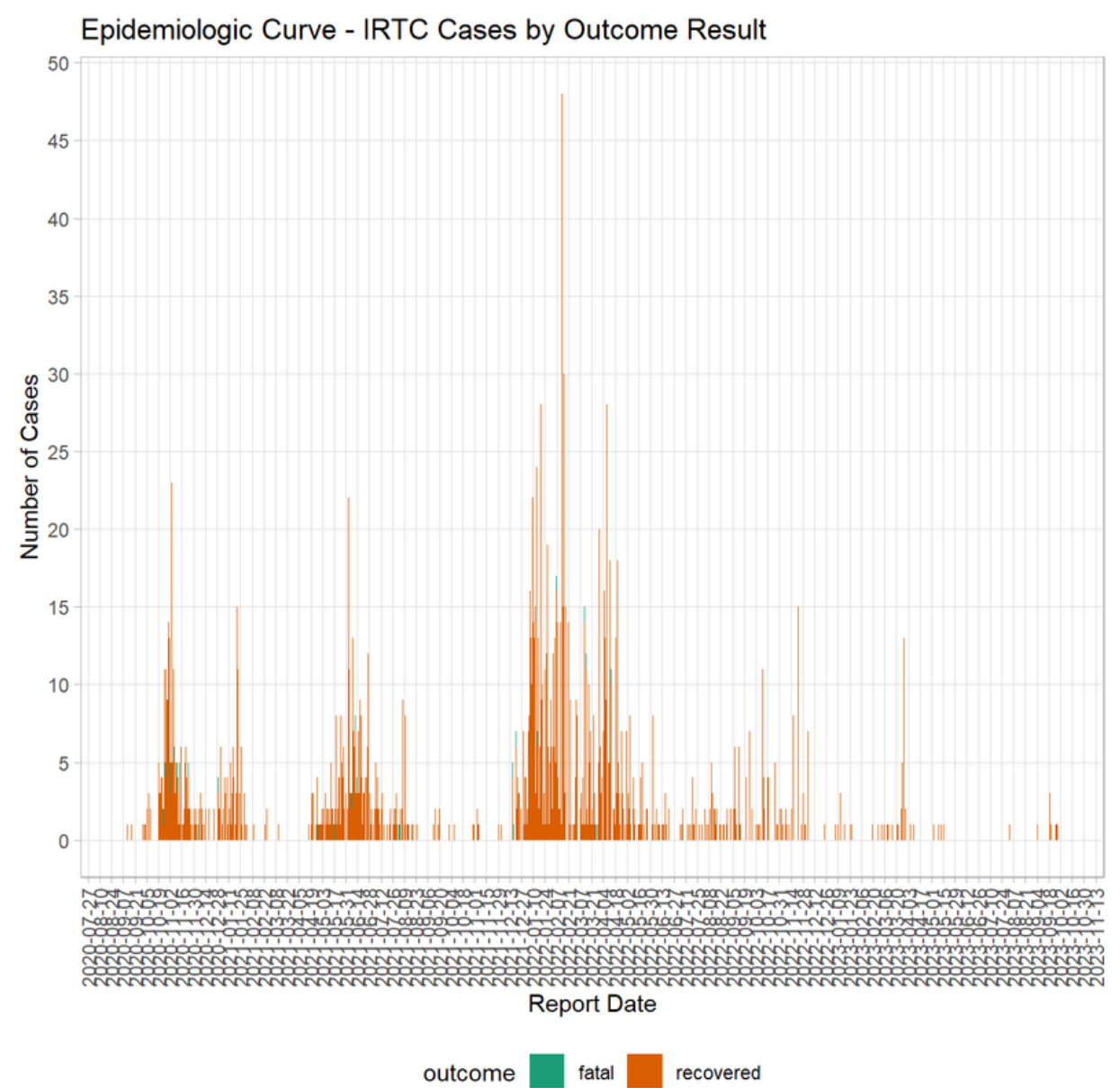
